



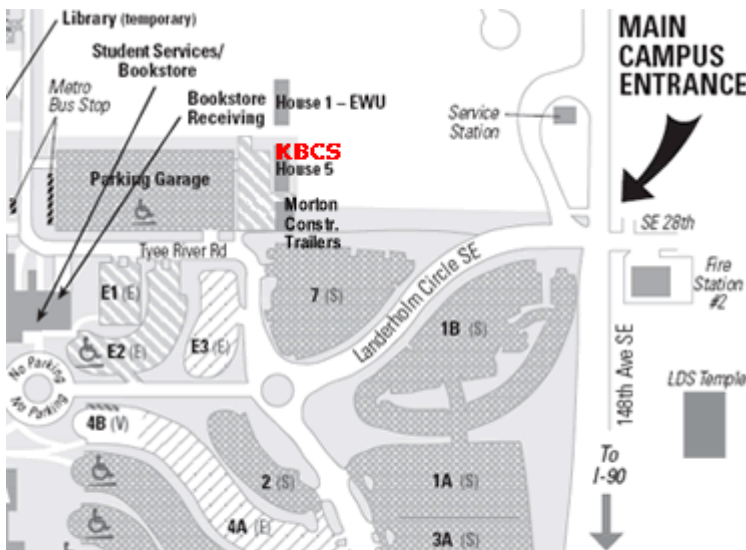
**Driving directions to KBCS on the campus of Bellevue Community College.**

**From Seattle:**

Follow I-90 eastbound. Take exit 11A, stay to the left and take the second exit to 156th Ave SE. The ramp will merge you onto S 150th heading North. Proceed through the first stoplight (SE Eastgate Way) and get in the left lane. At the second stoplight (SE 28th St) turn left into BCC's main entrance. Stay in the right lane and proceed to the roundabout; when you come upon the traffic circle the road will automatically take you to the right. Follow the signs to Eastern University. You will see the parking garage directly ahead and KBCS is in House 5 east of the parking garage, between the Morton Construction trailers and House 1 occupied by Eastern University. Park in the student parking garage. It is ok to park in the Student Parking garage if you are a volunteer or guest of KBCS. During the week when classes are in session, the top floor is your best option. There will be a sign that says "Employees only". You can ignore that sign. Please ask for a temporary parking permit at the station, which you will need to put the dashboard of your vehicle.

**From Issaquah :**

Take I-90 westbound to Exit 11. After exiting, follow the signs for 156th Ave SE. At the stoplight, turn left onto Eastgate Way. Move into the right lane and turn right at 150th Ave SE. Get in the left lane and proceed up the hill. At the stoplight (SE 28th St) turn left into BCC's main entrance. Stay in the right lane and proceed to the roundabout; when you come upon the traffic circle the road will automatically take you to the right. Follow the signs to Eastern University. You will see the parking garage directly ahead and KBCS is in House 5 east of the parking garage, between the Morton Construction trailers and House 1 occupied by Eastern University. Park in the student parking garage. It is ok to park in the Student Parking garage if you are a volunteer or guest of KBCS. During the week when classes are in session, the top floor is your best option. There will be a sign that says "Employees only". You can ignore that sign. Please ask for a temporary parking permit at the station, which you will need to put the dashboard of your vehicle.
